What is a SCUBA?

A Sheffield Credit Union Budgeting Account (SCUBA) has been designed to help you keep control of your money.

After paying your money into us, we then divide it up into smaller pots. Then when your bills are due we will make the agreed payments and return any money left over to you, in agreed regular amounts.

Each month you can pay up to five of your bills through our budgeting accounts. Discounts may apply to members who have their rent paid to some of Sheffield's largest housing associations (more information can be found opposite).



How Can A SCUBA Account Benefit You?

- Our SCUBA Account gives you the peace of mind knowing that your bills are going to be paid each month without you worrying if you have enough money left in the bank to pay them.
- Should you not have sufficient funds in your SCUBA account there will be no charge for failed payments and we will contact you to let you know of any issues.
- Any remaining money in the account can be sent back to you, so you are safe in the knowledge that the money you have in your bank account is yours to spend.
- In order to get a SCUBA Account you must also become a member of the Credit Union. As a result you have full access to all our services including:
 - \Rightarrow Instant access savings accounts
 - \Rightarrow 30 days notice savings account
 - \Rightarrow Christmas Saver account
 - \Rightarrow Affordable loans of £100 to 10,000*

*all loans subject to status and affordability and credit checks.
